

Internship Eligibility

- Students can apply for eligibility after they have completed 9 credits.
- Application include subject matter competency and recommendation letters. See all requirements and details on <u>Teaching Internship webpage</u>.

- <u>Group Advising sessions</u> are held each semester with presentations on program updates and requirements. Attendance is highly encouraged.


PRELIMINARY CREDENTIAL REQUIREMENTS

- <u>Subject Matter Competency:</u> Must be met by the designated student teaching application deadline or after semester 1 for internship eligibility.
- CPR Certificate: Recommend to complete during semester 1.
- <u>US Constitution Requirement:</u> Recommend to complete during semester 1.
- EDSP Workshop: The Health and AAC Workshops must be completed before advancing the fieldwork. Complete during semester 1 or 2.
- <u>RICA Exam:</u> Must be met for Preliminary Credential recommendation.
 Recommend to complete after meeting subject matter competency.
- <u>CalTPA Cycle 1 and 2</u>: Must be met for Preliminary Credential recommendation. Will be completed during student teaching or internship.
