Integrated Semester is a class for advanced students (typically juniors and seniors) who are ready to integrate their chosen fields of study into a large-scale project. Projects may vary, but all will combine a variety of learning modes—that is, integrate! These modes might include: research, business application, creative practice, experiential learning, analytic work, kinesthetic learning, activism, organizing, internships, teaching, etc. Application required to join class.

Meeting weekly, Integrated Semester functions as 1/4th project workshop, 1/4th academic therapy, 1/4th cheerleading session, and 1/4th motivational kick in the pants. Each week students will provide updates about their own work and offer feedback on their peers' projects. Together, we will also have weekly readings on what it takes and how to get s*&! done. Additionally, students will be required to keep a regularly updated online portfolio of their weekly work.

Candidates for Integrated Semester must have a graduation contract on file AND complete an application. Acceptance into Integrated Semester will be based on having a well-defined integrated project, as well as having a detailed plan of how the project will be brought to fruition.
