Alexander Lapins teaches at Northern Arizona University, Blue Lake Fine Arts Camp, Miraphone Academy of the West, and is tubist of the Elden Brass Quintet. A diverse artist, Dr. Lapins is an enthusiast of early music, has taught a class on the history of rock music, and is the only tubist to have won fellowships at both the Tanglewood Music Center and the Henry Mancini Institute. He has performed with the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra, Chicago Symphony Orchestra, Cincinnati Symphony Orchestra, Cincinnati Opera Orchestra, Disney Collegiate All-Star Band, the Guy Lombardo Orchestra, the New Sousa Band and Harvey Phillips' Tubacompany, and has performed in Europe, South America, China and all throughout the United States. Dr. Lapins has degrees from James Madison University, the University of Michigan and Indiana University.
