Gregory Reust, french horn



Gregory Reust is in his fourth year at the University of Redlands, pursuing a Bachelor of Music degree in Horn Performance under the tutelage of Laura Brenes. He began playing horn at the age of 12, studying with Lou Korell in Santa Clarita, California. In 2013, he was principal horn in both the CBDA All-State Wind Symphony and the SCSBOA All-Southern Orchestra.

During his time at Redlands, Gregory has played principal horn with the University Wind Ensemble and Orchestra, and has played in countless chamber groups. He has also performed with the Redlands Symphony Orchestra and the American Youth Symphony. In the Fall of 2015, he spent a semester living in Vienna, Austria, learning about European musical culture and studying horn with Franz Söllner of the Vienna Philharmonic.

When not playing horn, Gregory works as an audio engineer and freelance keyboardist. He enjoys exploring a wealth of musical genres and will be appearing this year as the pianist of the University Studio Big Band. Gregory is a member of Phi Mu Alpha and Pi Kappa Lambda.
